(The Boston Globe is owned by The New York Times Company.)

Local churches should take the lead in mobilizing their people to cancel their subscriptions (accompanied by phone calls of explanation) as well as to apply pressure to advertisers who provide the financial base for the newspaper.

Conservative evangelicals historically have floundered in trying to impact the political process effectively. The Los Angeles Times has already experienced significant staff layoffs that can be traced at least in part to its liberal bias."

It is similar in content and format to the two other major U. S. newsmagazines, Time sees its mission as a periodical covering the news from a centrist point of view. Secret #66 U. S. News & World Report

I was once a subscriber in my print media days when I subscribed to many business periodicals. I enjoyed USN&WR. I did not detect much overt bias. U. S. News & World Report has earned a reputation as the leading provider of service news and information that improves the quality of life of its readers by focusing on health, personal finance, education, travel, cars, news and opinion.

It is one of just three major newsweeklies published in the United States today. The magazine tends to focus on the practical issues associated with current events. It is rated by most to be moderately conservative.

Secret #67 Taxation w/o Representation

This is a fine book in is third edition as written by your author. The book relies on the Constitution, the founding documents, Articles of Association, Declaration of Rights and Grievances, Declaration of Independence, and the Bill of Rights. Taxation without Representation unearths and explores a massive dilemma for U.S. Citizens.

You can safely read the Wall Street Journal. The Wall Street Journal is controlled by Rupert Murdoch via Dow Jones Publications, which in turn is owned by Murdoch's News Corp. Murdoch owns a controlling 39.4% voting stake in both News Corp and 21st Century Fox. News Corp purchased the newspaper for \$6 billion in 2007 from the Bancroft family. It is a mostly conservative, business-oriented publication, but it is less overtly political than Murdoch's other major media outlet, Fox News.

Sometimes the Journal goes off the conservative reservation so watch out.

Secret #70 Chicago Tribune
