Sean Hannity does not call himself a Democrat or a Republican. He says he is a registered Conservative. Regardless of his political affiliation, Hannity has made a big name for himself at the conservative-leaning Fox News Channel.

Hannity was born in 1961 in New York City, so he is not a midwesterner and did not grow up in fly-over country. Regarding all things New York, his attitude on the big tube is Sergeant Schults-like "I know nothing." Actually Sean knows a lot about socialism and progressivism and he has sworn off the diseases. Though he lives in NY to this day, he acts more like a mid-westerner, and we're glad he does.

He might has well be from Missouri for his political leanings are the same. Sean attended New York and Adelphi universities but like Rush Limbaugh, a colleague and ratings competitor, he left acasemia without gaining the coveted sheepskin to finish his degree. Nonetheless, at the tender age of twenty-seven years old, he in 1989, he got his first radio gig at KCSB FM in Santa Barbara, California. But he forgot he was in California and thought that truth was more important than power. .But, after Hannity expressed his thoughts to the public, the station fired him after he made controversial remarks about homosexuality.

Hannity moved to where he could get some work outside of California. His next stop was two conservative radio stations in Georgia. He got his big break when Fox News hired him in 1996 to cohost "Hannity & Colmes," with Alan Colmes, a more liberal voice. When the show ended in 2009, the Network gave Sean his own show called "Hannity."

For Sean, it's been going pretty well since 1996, when Hannity was handpicked by Roger Ailes as part of the original team at Fox that more or less redefined cable news. At the time, there was local news and CNN. Because of Ailes and picks like Sean Hannity, Fox torpedoed the unspoken standard that news should be impartial and tapped into an audience incredibly thirsty for some true and conservative commentary.

Most Fox advocates never liked the idea of the Colmes opinion and do not like FAIR and Balanced when the other networks do not know how to spell either word. Under his boss's tutelage, Hannity became a sensation, making viewers at home squeal with glee as he filleted his squishy co-host Alan Colmes, Fox's house liberal, until he went solo in 2008. Even though Hannity got the best of Colmes, Alan had the tough role in trying to make sense out of the politics of the asinine left.

Like many talk show hosts, Hannity also got the "quick buck" bookwriting bug. Fox encourages this and then the network helps their hosts make some extra dough by presenting their books like part of the show on network time. Hannity's books include "Let Freedom Ring: Winning the War of Liberty Over Liberalism," "Deliver Us from Evil: Defeating Terrorism, Despotism, and Liberalism," and his newest book, "Conservative Victory: Defeating Obama's Radical Agenda." We can expect more from Hannity on the writing front. After a little discovery in 1996 and some priceless mentoring, about twenty-years later, his media efforts have led to a personal net worth of \$80 million, according to TheRichest.com.

Hannity continues as the host of the "Hannity" show on Fox News and he continues to live in New York with his wife Jill Rhodes and their two children Patrick and Merri Kelly. Sean is a gun enthusiast and pistol marksman.

He had no chance to become a spoiled brat as his parents were loving but firm. They were nowhere near a millionaire's net worth. Thus. Sean worked many different jobs and he talks often of having no aversion to hard work. One of his most viewed tweets is the following: "I am a former dishwasher,cook,painter, paper hanger, carpenter waiter busboy and paperboy."

That need to work matches my own as a young child and teenager as I was a junk man, a sidewalk snow-shoveler, a grass-cutter, a corsage maker, an ice-cream cake seller, a 5&10 stock boy, a pin boy, a soda delivery guy, and a paper boy.

And, with my mom and dad each being one of ten children, there were lots of aunts and uncles. So, before I was five years old, with the help of my older brother Ed and sister Nancy, I became a prolific uncle and aunt chiseler when they visited and mom and dad were not looking. My sister and brother always shared in the proceeds. We knew the value of a buck, or should I say we knew the value of a nickel and a dime. I bet Sean did also.

Sean was the youngest child and only son of first-generation Irish immigrants Hugh and Lillian, Hannity. He grew up in Franklin Square, a Long Island suburb of New York. Both parents worked in the justice system: His mom Lillian was a corrections officer and court stenographer and his dad Hugh was an officer in New York City's family court system.

Always a Catholic and always pro-life from his youth, Hannity attended local Catholic schools, followed by stints at Long Island's Adelphi University, New York University and the University of California-Santa Barbara. As noted, he did not finish. Instead he chose to focus on a career in radio, which was his fascination since childhood. Hannity married his wife Jill Rhodes in 1993, and the couple has two children. Hannity is a good family man.

In his job at Fox, sometimes Sean gets to report from the field periodically. For example, he traveled to Israel in 2014 to interview Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu during the Israel/Gaza conflict As Fox reconstructs its nightly line-up periodically, for the most part they let Hannity alone as he is their #1 guy in 2018.

His liberal progressive foes in other media outlets like to call him an anachronism but to those of us who love America, he is one of our most beloved leaders in our fight for truth and American values.

Sean has won a number of awards for his work on Fox News, including two NAB Marconi Radio Awards for Network Syndicated Personality of the Year in 2003. He's also won the Radio & Records National Talk Show Host of the Year Award three consecutive years times from 2003 to 2005.

"Talkers Magazine" ranks Sean Hannity #2 in its Top 100 Talk Show Hosts in America, and in 2013 he made it to 72 on the "Forbes" Celebrity 100 list. In 2017, he won the Gene Burns Memorial Award for Freedom of Speech from "Talkers Magazine."

He is not the only conservative media host with a lot of money and a huge fan base. Two others notable are Rush Limbaugh and the now back in vogue Bill O'Reilly. Both are worth well over \$100 million.

It was not long after his career with Fox began that he found his way on radio to WABC Radio in NYC. He had his own show, aptly titled "The Sean Hannity Show (1998–). Like the Rush Limbaugh show and his EIB, Hannity's show was eventually syndicated on more than 500 stations in the United States. Looking for a Saturday job, Sean also hosted the Fox News Channel show titled Hannity's America. He was the perfect host for the show as a weekly conservative currentaffairs program.

When time was up for Hannity & Colmes in 2009, Hannity was given the time slot once occupied by the cohosted show and his natural conservative slant helped him with his audience. For example, during the presidential election of 2016, Hannity was an outspoken supporter of the Republican nominee Donald J. Trump and an ardent critic of Trump's Democratic opponent, Hillary Clinton. While Fox itself straddles the line between conservative and liberal/progressive thinking, Hannity serves the network well on the conservative side.

Following Trump's election as President in November 2016, as far as the Fox audience is concerned, Hannity became known as Trump's most reliable defender among political commentators in all of television.

For eight years, Hannity was a vocal critic of President Obama in most of his anti-American decisions. He was also very outspoken regarding the Obama actions during the recession-era housing crisis. Hannity also saw that if he looked hard at Obama's poor economy, there were some ways that he could make some money on the economic downturn even if he could not fix it.

So, he took advantage of the economic downturn to buy foreclosed homes at low rates. Additional properties were bought with assistance from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development, or HUD, a fact that Hannity did not disclose when HUD Secretary Ben Carson recently appeared as a guest on Hannity's Fox program. If it were a Democrat with all facts the same, of course, there would be no question of propriety.

As we discussed, Hannity was fired from his first radio gig but even before Fox brought him in, he made the best of being fired from the college station, KCSB. The resulting controversy made him popular in conservative circles and he turned this controversy into his first paid radio position, at WVNN in Athens, Alabama, in 1990. Within a few years, his afternoon program topped the local market, and he became even better known in conservative circles. Good fortune comes to the competent and the hard working.

It all came to fruition down south, when Hannity was able to forge an early relationship with another popular and famous conservative, Georgia Congressman Newt Gingrich. It was in Alabama that Hannity also met his future bride, Jill Rhodes. In the pre-Fox period from 1992 to 1996, the Hannity show aired on Atlanta's WGST. In January 1997, a few months after the premiere of his Fox television program, Hannity leveraged his popularity to become part of New York's WABC, where his show aired in the latenight hours before moving to the plum afternoon "drive time" slot. Hannity changed his radio home again in early 2014, as he moved his show to New York's WOR.

Looking back at a successful radio career, Hannity's radio program went into national syndication on September 10, 2001, and today it airs on more than 500 stations. *Talkers Magazine* estimates Hannity's weekly radio audience at 13.5 million, placing him just behind Rush Limbaugh's 14 million listeners when the poll was taken. Limbaugh is now up to 26 million while Hannity also is up there a little above or at times, perhaps a little below.

The blurb would read that Sean Hannity, the syndicated radio host heard locally on New 95.5 and AM 750 WSB, has supplanted Rush Limbaugh on Talkers' Magazine's annual Heavy Hundred list of influential radio talkers. Sean is surely very popular but before I suggest gospel, I'd want to see what Rush thinks. What do you think?

There is no question that Sean Hannity is great! I'd love him to talk to me directly about my campaign. He seems like the kind of a guy who would love either Jefferson Smith or John Q. When I was in my twenties, the "Brewery" brought back Liebotschaner, a finely crafted and aged old-time Stegmaier formulation. The company made its beer from fresh grains and hops and malt and it aged all of its products in huge vats on the left side of Market St. as one headed up Brewery Hill. [So! If you want a beer that's mellow, a beer that is really grand, say hey, make mine Stegmaier, the gold medal beer of the land. And, so at home, or club, or tap room; always order the beer that they cheer. Served just right; mellow, cool, and light, Stegmaier Gold Medal Beer.]

The paragraph above is the essence of the 1960's Stegmaier commercial.

My dad was pretty good at what he did, and he took his work seriously. For a number of years before its demise, Stegmaier had one of the fastest canning machines in Pennsylvania. My dad operated this behemoth single-handedly. For its day, it was an awesome machine. It put out 600 cans per minute. That's even fast according to today's standards. My dad was quite a guy.

My father and I regularly had discussions about beliefs and ideologies and which candidate truly was best for official jobs, at the local, state, and federal levels. More often than not, he and I were on the same page. My dad's philosophy was that you should always vote for the best candidate for the job, not simply the political party. These discussions eventually prompted me to cancel my registration as an independent and become a Democrat. In Pennsylvania, Independents have no voice in the primary elections.

Yes, there is a corollary to that precept: "I do not want the government controlling your life."

I can recall some great people in my life making comments that now make so much sense. For example, Dennis Grimes Senior from Fulton Street in Wilkes-Barre, who, when told that Congress did not get much done this term, would always say: "good!" Then, of course with the twinkle in his Irish eyes, he would add a little priceless gem to make the sentence end well, and I would smile. How profound he was.

Each time Congress meets we lose more freedom. There are too many people who think that you should do this, and you should do that. It is bad news when they get into office. They want to make sure you do it and they have the power to make laws to make it mandatory. I want to let you alone to lead your own life, and I hope if you are in similar circumstance, that you will let me alone to lead my life.

I believe that freedom is our most important gift. Our forefathers shed their blood for our freedom and liberty. Freedom has no real limits but being a good person does add restrictions to freedom.

For example, I believe that in many and possibly most cases, a particular individual's freedom ends where another person's freedom begins. So, there will always be disputes between people and so it is OK to have some rules that help arbitrate man's behavior to his fellow man. My favorite rule book was created by the Founders. For me, it really is all about freedom, which is the positive of "no government control." I do not want government monitoring or controlling of my life from womb to tomb or any other area in between. I have written twenty-some additional books between my first run for Congress and now, many of which include a full copy of the Constitution of the United States.

The Constitution was created in order to form a "more perfect union," since it corrected a number of flaws in the Articles of Confederation. It is not perfect, but it is lots better than Nancy Pelosi and Harry Reid and Barack Obama making up freedom-destroying rules on the fly, as they go along.

I will never do that again as I had to shut down my life and the lives of too many friends. We were out getting signatures but since all of us have some type of gainful employment, we could not have an exhaustive campaign and did not and will not try to knock on doors. It is tough enough just penning these articles.

Chapter 4 It's Tough Being Unknown!



Everybody knows somebody sometime

It is not such a good thing when "everybody knows somebody sometime" and you are not on the list. When you are the new guy, sometimes the press forgets. That is my problem this year with no choice but to run as a write-in candidate to get my unique platform adopted by somebody such as Lou Barletta or by myself when elected to the Senate.

I do not think Bob Casey would be good for PA and so more than running against Casey and Barletta, I am continuing the primary and running against Bob Casey Jr. Of course, I'll take any Republican votes I can get.

I fear that if I were to bring my unique platform points as revealed in the Speech in Chapter 8 to Bob Casey's attention, he would adopt them as part of his platform and he would be unbeatable by me or by Lou Barletta. As a nobody, as much as I want these platform points adopted for the good of America, having Bob Casey Jr. back in office hurting the Trump agenda as the Senior Senator from PA would be too high a price to pay.

Many of my friends ask me how I hope to get known by people who live in any of the sixty-seven counties that make up Pennsylvania. Let me tell you, it is tough without major political financing. But, we must persevere with press releases, letters to the media, and make a speech whenever asked. To get the attention of the press, a candidate must first "press" his nose against the glass of the media outlets (Newspaper, Radio, and TV) to get their attention. Unfortunately for unknown and not-well financed candidates, in my experience in having run unsuccessfully three times, the priority of the management of media outlets is to maintain their viability by bringing in ad revenue and not giving up space or time to citizen candidates. I know that it will not be smooth sailing, but nothing ventured, nothing gained.

Fortunately, I can set up and manage web sites and I can use Facebook. Therefore, I can reach web surfers without any cost. This time, I will not have a Donate Button to accept contributions but that is OK as I won't need an accountant when it is over to figure out the financial statements. Because it is a state-wide election yard signs in the local community will not be effective, so I will save on that.

In their article, Journalism in the Digital Age, five Stanford (cs.stanford.edu) authors-- Danny Crichton, Ben Christel, Aaditya Shidham, Alex Valderrama, Jeremy Karmel, take the time to explain the absolute importance of a Fourth Estate (the media) as the most important pillar of our Democratic Republic: Too bad we have the Fake News Media instead.

Here is what they say:

"Journalism has long been regarded as an important force in government, so vital to the functioning of a democracy that it has been portrayed as an integral component of democracy itself. In 1841, Thomas Carlyle wrote, "Burke said there were Three Estates in Parliament; but, in the Reporters' Gallery yonder, there sat a Fourth Estate more important far than they all" (On Heroes and Hero Worship).

Four years earlier, Carlyle had used the phrase in his French Revolution: "A Fourth Estate, of Able Editors, springs up, increases and multiplies; irrepressible, incalculable." Carlyle saw the press as instrumental to the birth and growth of democracy, spreading facts and opinions and sparking revolution against tyranny.

"The fact of the matter is that democracy requires informed citizens. No governing body can be expected to operate well without knowledge of the issues on which it is to rule, and rule by the people entails that the people should be informed. In a representative democracy, the role of the press is twofold: it both informs citizens and sets up a feedback loop between the government and voters.

The press makes the actions of the government known to the public, and voters who disapprove of current trends in policy can take corrective action in the next election. Without the press, the feedback loop is broken, and the government is no longer accountable to the people. The press is therefore of the utmost importance in a representative democracy. Today, the press is more concerned with making fake news than with reporting real news, so it will be a tough challenge indeed.

"Another, related, function of the press is to expose people to opinions contrary to their own. This function is perhaps the most valuable in the Internet age; while people can in theory get information about the actions of their government from online sources, it is all too easy to find opinions online that match one's own. Informed decision-making on the part of voters requires an awareness of multiple points of view, which is not likely to be obtained if voters bear the sole responsibility of seeking out information on relevant issues.

The news media provides a forum for debates to take place, as well as moderating and curating the arguments presented by all sides. It is, of course, idealistic to suppose that media give equal, or even proportional, representation to all opinions, but the fact that many media outlets present themselves as nonpartisan sources of information makes them a better forum for debate than online sources such as blogs, which are typically maintained by one individual or a small group of people with similar opinions..."

It would be nice if the mainstream media took the time to provide forums in their media to inform the public of the candidacies of all citizens running in all elections. Even if it were not every day, and the media used its power to permit short speeches to be carried on their on-line sites. The media's job in our Republic is to inform the public and let me just say they can do a far better job than what they do. When you consider that in the three times that I have run for office, the media was mostly MIA, I can say I know from experience.

I have not even been interviewed or permitted to participate in any event on Public Television, even though we the people pay for it. I was interviewed when I ran for Mayor on Election Day but the channel WBRE TV in my home town chose not to run the video. Let me repeat, the media does a disservice to the community by not informing the public of its choices.

I have never been endorsed by any media outlet as I have never been well known by their advertising departments.

Reporters and Newspaper Executives are not easy to move to your side. They do not feel obligated to assure that the public knows what each candidate has to offer.

The Press's problem in this general election season is that "Nobody expects that a guy 'who nobody knows,' will run for office." And so, I know that as a candidate, I will be very close to being summarily ignored.

I do not think that anybody in the press tries to purposely hurt me or any other candidate, but they have their favorites. From my experience in the past, even after writing letters to the editor and sending multiple press releases trying to assure the media that I am a viable candidate, I found myself excluded from much of the news coverage. Whether it was intentional or not, no media outlet tried to make up for the loss of publicity my campaigns suffered. I would hope that regardless of how well known a candidate may be in this upcoming election, the papers and the other news media of NEPA should permit candidates to do things that help the people become informed about where they stand on the major issues of the day. In the past, I have had few vehicles provided for me that would help the people know who I am.

Thus, anybody other than an incumbent or one well-endowed by blessings (cash) can expect to be relegated to the back seat in an election.



The charter of the press is to provide news to the people, and news about who may be chosen to represent the people is worthy news indeed.

For me, the bottom line is that it is not easy for democracy to continue when the people have a tough time getting on the ballot and then they must fight against mythical forces to convince even their neighbors that they are serious in the endeavor. My political friends say that is the nature of the beast. I say, the beast is the problem.

Campaign Update August 3, 2018

The reaction of my U.S. Senate candidacy by the people of Pennsylvania has been quite heartening. We have a president whose interest quite simply is to "Make America Great Again." By contrast, the embedded establishment and liberal leftovers in the SWAMP, have no interest in performing what is good for our country. They are doing their best to undermine our president, without any repercussions, aided and abetted by a corrupt media, instead of building bridges to work for the good of all Americans.

Electing representatives of the people is not a triviality, but rather the expression of the most fundamental right of self-government. Without it, of course, this great United States would be like any other country in the world. It would not be the exceptional republic, which we the people have enjoyed since our own Declaration of Independence.

I hope you will find the elements of my platform a welcome refreshment and inclusive of precepts that we all embrace and recognize as sincere and necessary.

My format will be to be present each issue by area of concern and then offer the specific solution which is part of my unique platform. The issues and solutions will be presented one by one in the following four topical areas:

#1—Obamacare.

#2—Illegal Immigration.

#3—Student Debt Crisis Wipe Out All Student Debt Now!

#4—Social Security's Cost-of-Living Fraud – Boost Social Security Now!

My pledge is to put forth legislation when elected to help address all four issues as well as full support for the platform points in Chapter 7 and the Trump agenda. Let's discuss the unique four-points above, one by one, starting with Obamacare.

Obamacare

The first problem on the list is #1 because over 54% of Americans say that the availability and affordability of healthcare is their #1 issue. Despite Obama's empty promises, many of us cannot keep our favorite doctors nor can we retain an affordable health plan that meets our needs. The costs have been so prohibitive that many Americans have forestalled doctor's visits with often grave consequences. We all know that despite what Bob Casey would offer you, Obamacare is a disaster.

My solution to Obamacare begins with clarity and definitive purpose. We start with a one-line repeal. The beast is vanquished. Following the repeal, we envision a plethora of competing less expensive alternatives provided by the marketplace without current tyrannical government controls.

Illegal Immigration

In February 2004, Arizona Senator John McCain recognized via Border Patrol reports that nearly four million people crossed our borders "illegally" each year following the Reagan amnesty in 1986. Nonetheless, the fraudulent press insists that the total count of illegal immigrants residing in the United States is eleven million, a mathematical impossibility if Border Patrol figures are to be believed. And of these millions of foreigners, countless amounts receive welfare while, contrary to popular mythology, very few actually work in agriculture.

There may be as many as 60 million and perhaps more illegal foreign nationals living in the United States today. While some individuals in this group may contribute to our society, on balance this is outweighed by the group's overall negative effect on our resources, whether they be drained by government assistance, lost employment opportunities for American citizens, or criminal offenses. It is amazing how effective the fake-ID business is in turning illegal aliens into fake citizens who are thus enabled to enjoy American rights and privileges.

According to the 2011 GAO report entitled "Criminal Alien Statistics," the cost of crimes by illegal foreign nationals is \$8.1 billion per year, and that's without even considering the incomprehensibly larger emotional toll this takes on families whose priceless loved ones can never be replaced.

If elected, I will introduce two pieces of legislation that will solve this problem of illegal residents in the shadows once and for all. Besides many other benefits, it stands to save the U.S. over \$1 Trillion per year in addition to major reductions in crime. The two solutions are known as pay-to-go and the resident visa program.

Pay-to-Go

It costs taxpayers \$30,000 per year on the average, per illegal alien in America. Each illegal resident and their dependent children, who signs up for Pay to Go, on the way back to the home country, will receive a one-time \$20,000 stipend plus the individual expense back to the home country. With a cost of \$30,000 per year to support unwelcome interlopers, the taxpayer savings begins year one and continues at \$30,000 per year forever. Not a bad deal for Americans.

The program therefore quietly accommodates family reunification in the home country. A family of five for example, could do quite well back home after receiving \$100,000 in stipends from Uncle Sam. Reuniting families in their own countries is a good idea for them and for America. The savings in welfare means there is no cost in year one and in year 2, the savings equal \$30,000 for each person who "goes." back home, never to return.

Resident Visa

Those who do not want to leave the US can sign up, be vetted, and eventually be approved for the Resident Visa. The visa will cost \$200.00 to cover vetting in year one and it will be renewable every year thereafter for \$100.00 To get a Resident Visa, a former interloper would agree to all stipulations after registering. Stipulations would include full initial vetting; onsite renewal vetting; keep existing jobs; new jobs for Americans first; no voting; no citizenship; no welfare and no freebies of any kind. Everybody is not automatically approved. After vetting, those not approved for the resident visa program may use the Pay-to-Go program to aid in their relocation.

As the program would entail 100% participation from illegal residents, estimates are as high as \$500 billion per year cost savings in total for those who choose to go or for those who choose to stay using the nowelfare resident visa. Another \$500 billion will be reclaimed over time for lost wages. Additionally, if we can figure a way for countries to reclaim their criminals, there is another \$8.1 billion to be recovered.

Once the program is in effect, there would be no more illegal aliens in the country. Resident Visa holders would be legal and so there would be no shadows. There would be no need for DACA and no need for Sanctuary cities Let me repeat that. All issues with DACA would be over and Sanctuary Cities would be a thing of the past because there would be no shadows and no illegal interlopers.

Two additional programs are the part of my platform that I would now like to introduce. Like the resident alien plans, no other candidate for public office includes these great programs in their platform. You are going to love these.

These two new programs offer the promise of a positive effect on the health of the economy and both will contribute to improving it for

American citizens of all ages to live well in this country. The first is about wiping out all student debt and the second is about offering Social Security recipients increased benefits to make up for fraudulent cost of living increases based on an intentionally fraudulent consumer price index.

Student Debt is Huge

If we look at the \$1.48 Trillion dollars in student loan debt that more and more young adults simply cannot repay, some have asked: "Why do our young people no longer matter?" Do they matter?

We live in an age when everybody seems to have a reason to pick on millennials. They would not loan a "spoiled" millennial "ingrate" as much as a dollar for a cup of coffee.

Whether millennials are deserving of the bad rap or not, they represent a lost generation of our society. For the sake of all of America, they need to be invited back in. We all have student loan debtors in our families – sons, daughters, nephews, nieces, even grandparents and parents when we consider cosigners.

I plan to offer legislation when first elected to make sure we solve this nasty American problem. There have been many other debt reliefs in our history but none that could deliver such an immediate benefit to so many actual Americans all at once. The upside would be overwhelming, a joint humanitarian return and a major economic return far greater than any bailout in history. Let's consider.

A Bailout is a Bailout?

Many of us remember bailouts of the past from 2007 onward. We had bank bailouts, auto company bailouts, TARP bailouts and many other unnamed bailouts. Did any of these help your family? Of course not. Bailout fever began right before Obama became President and continued. The President managed all of the money—trillions. He chose not to give a dime to help student loan debt but spared no expense showering the degenerate financial institutions that owned his candidacy with gold.

Mike Collins, a Forbes Magazine contributor whose expertise focuses on manufacturing and government policy (not the former beloved magistrate of Wilkes-Barre who shares the same name) had this to say:

"Most people think that the big bank bailout was the \$700 billion that the treasury department used to save the banks during the financial crash in September of 2008. But this is a long way from the truth because the bailout [ten years later] is still ongoing.

The Special Inspector General for TARP's summary of the bailout says that the total commitment of government is \$16.8 trillion dollars with the \$4.6 trillion already paid out. The [same] banks are now larger and still too big to fail. But it isn't just the government bailout money that tells the story of the bailout. This is a story about lies, cheating, and a multi-faceted corruption, which was often criminal."

Like most elements of his presidency, Obama made the situation worse when he commandeered the student loans from Sallie Mae and other lenders. The government now pulls in more than \$50 billion a year from charging high interest rates to student borrowers. The Obama Student Loan Company charged 6.8% as a student interest rates. The CBO estimates that the interest rate on these loans could quickly be reduced from 6.8 percent to 5.3 percent if Obama had not earmarked the profit from the backs of students to subsidize Obamacare.

Not only were millennials duped into huge college loans when they were so young that Clearasil was one of their major expenses, they were duped into believing Obama was in their corner.

I believe these student victims deserve a break. They are now adults. Some stuck with huge cosign tabs are grandparents on Social security. The government actually garnishes their SSR to pay back the Obama loans.

The federal government is putting up \$16.8 trillion dollars as of 2018 to big banks, and other nameless faces receiving bailouts. We still do

not know who is getting our money. Yet students who are still being victimized by usury were preyed on as 17-year- olds by admissions counsellors for an all-but worthless college education leading to no job. If given the choice would you be helping the big banks or our own kids?

What do the people think about Student Debt?

Four in ten Americans believe that President Trump's administration should forgive all federal student debt in order to help stimulate the economy, according to a reasonably new survey revealed in 2017. As time goes by as more Americans realize we are excluding a full generation of Americans in our economy, this number will increase from a simple majority to an overwhelming endorsement of wiping out this scurrilous unfair debt as soon as possible. We should bring these 48 million students back into the American way of life as soon as possible.

The largest share blame for the student debt crisis lies with the promises made by over-zealous admissions counsellors convincing kids to sign up for \$100,000 loans. No American can want a full generation of other Americans to be left behind in the Trump economy. We need this debt eradicated now and to install safeguards so that seventeen-year-olds in the future are never asked again to sign up for a life in debtor's prison.

According to MoneyTips.com, attitudes have changed from a time when Americans thought college students should be punished for making bad choices to today, when we could use 48 million new spenders in our economy. They would be unleashed into a world of productivity if no longer burdened with massive debt. Many of us know first-hand the consequences of this debt burden. Though millennials may not be the most gracious in asking for help, they are Americans, not DACA immigrants, and they need our help now.

The raw economic fact regardless of your philosophical preference is that spenders with the greatest potential to spend today are not spending at all in real numbers because of student debt. They are not getting married. They are not having families and they are not buying homes. We must solve this scourge on our country so that this generation can produce other generations of Americans.

I am pledging today to solve this problem as soon as I can. I am ready to take action. I hope you all agree. Let's help these young Americans before they are lost forever.

Young teenagers were told all through high school that the best ticket for a successful life is a college education. Is this true today? Their salaries often lag behind even those of non-college educated professionals such as plumbers, electricians, computer repair personnel, operating engineers, and more. Because of their reliance on these deliberately false misrepresentations, they now owe an approximate average of \$50,000 in student debt while their admissions counsellors and loan sharks revel in riches, in their Mercedes, BMW's, and third vacation home on the lake.

Unscrupulous malefactors with self-interested agendas persuaded America's teenagers, many so young they still had Acne vulgaris, to dig themselves huge financial holes with no escape. Right now, we need a mere 10% of that to pay for the write-off of student debt without hurting taxpayers and without putting any banks under. The savings over three years, for example from the resident visa program alone pays off all the student debt that exists today. Why support illegal aliens when we can help Americans?

One last point. It helps to recall that President Obama increased the National Debt by \$9.1 Trillion in just eight years, hoping to assure that illegal aliens had all the resources they needed to take as many American jobs as they could. This is six times the amount of debt owed by young Americans. Obama nearly doubled our debt. And what do we have to show for that? As is typical for the Obama years, the answer is frankly... nothing. By contrast, debt relief for our young Americans will be *visibly* positive in its impact.

So, let's say Congress wipes out all student debt because it is the fair thing to do. How do we prevent this from every happening again? For this, I thank my great friend, Dennis Grimes whose solution combines some skin in the game for Academic Institutions to the mix and thus assures that no student will ever carry debt unless the student is successful with a job in their field of study. Here is how the new loan system would work.

Nobody gets a loan unless the college or university agrees to take all of the risk of the loan. If the student is successful, she or he will pay reasonable amounts on a monthly basis. If the student is jobless, since the university vouched for the student, the school will owe all of the debt. Academic institutions are smart. They will stop lending quickly to students with very little prospects of being able to pay the loan back. If students do not maintain acceptable averages, they will be expelled, and the university will pay their balance. If they want to go to college in the future, it will be cash only. What do you think?

A Rigged System

I am confident that President Trump would re-enfranchising America's youngest generation of adults by eradicating student debt and pay the balance via savings no longer spent subsidizing illegal immigrants.

In his own words, regarding recent graduates: "They go, and they work, and they take loans, and they're borrowed up, and they can't breathe, and they get through college and the worst thing is, they go through that whole process and they don't have any job." Trump has it right. He sees how this rigged system has snuffed out the optimism of a bright generation that now gives way to cynicism and despair.

If I am elected as your Senator, I will help enact legislation that eradicates all Student Debt, effective immediately.

Boost Social Security Now

Social Security is no longer publicly discussed by our duplicitous media despite the fact that seniors' issues need the spotlight now more than ever. The middle class has seen its purchasing power decline dramatically in the last three decades, forcing more and more people to seek entitlements when their savings are gone. And as long as pay raises and benefit increases are tied to a false CPI, this trend will continue.

In the past, nobody was anxious to throw the proverbial grandma under the bus. Now, believe it or not, hordes of constituencies are lining up to be the first to fleece what should belong to her into the eternal abyss, never to be seen again. The list of offenders includes: Congress, government officials, professors in academia, the "greatest" economic advisors the world has ever known, and dejected stand-alone economists who failed to gain tenure at a university.

This group of elite misfits have formed a diabolical consortium to cheat seniors out of their due cost of living increases promised from the very day the SSR act was passed by Franklin Delano Roosevelt.

As the mainstream Democrats kowtow to cultural elites and financial institutions, turning their backs on the workers and middle-class that defined their constituency for much of the 20th century, it is up to us to pick up the slack and fight for the rights of everyday Americans. When SSR was enacted, the president promised full dollar value throughout the years in order to ensure its passage in 1933. Many Americans are concerned that the Social Security program itself may not be able to sustain itself while others see the government cheating on the cost of living increases (CPI) thereby predetermining a life of squalor for seniors.

All successful societies throughout the ages, have maintained respect and dignity for their elders. Not only is cheating seniors a moral failure, it is a sign of a civilization entering an era of decay.

While seniors are losing their homes and many, for want of bread and milk, are on the verge of heading to the proverbial poorhouse or worse—the clutches of the Grim Reaper, Congress in 2018 pretended to care, giving a 2% raise, but then quickly snatched it right back in the dead of night via a Medicare Part B premium increase. This additional Medicare Part B charge for necessary health services for seniors was excluded from the cost of living calculations.

Thus, to pay Medicare part B, seniors are forced to use their "generous" 2% raises there, rather than to offset the costs brought forth from inflation in 2017 for which the 2% was intended. Since the real inflationary cost increases were closer to 11%, that means that instead of 9% that seniors were to endure, they accrued a full load of 11% in price increases. It's easy to understand why this constant drainage of resources is unsustainable for a senior citizen.

How did we reach this point?

Early in the administration of disgraced former President Bill Clinton, an economist named Michael Boskin, and Alan Greenspan, Chairman of the Board of Governors of the Federal Reserve System, devised a scheme that would allow for market basket "substitutions" to artificially lower the cost of living and result in lower payments to our oldest Americans. Prior to their involvement, the consumer price index (CPI) was measured using the cost of a fixed basket of goods, a fairly simple and straightforward concept.

The identical basket of goods would be priced at prevailing market costs for each period, and the period-to-period change in the cost of that market basket represented the rate of inflation in terms of maintaining a constant standard of living. That was self-evidently fair and reasonable, and predictably resulted in seniors receiving annual COLA increases in tandem with the prices of goods actually increasing.

But Boskin and Alan Greenspan argued that when one item in the basket, for instance steak, became too expensive, the consumer would substitute hamburger for the steak, and that the inflation measure should reflect the costs tied to buying hamburger rather than the steak. Eventually, it became OK for the bureaucrats to replace hamburger with less expensive tuna and eventually because the protein value was the same, cat tuna replaced regular tuna in the market basket. To further obscure the true cost of living, other items were selectively removed from the basket when the prices were high and then reinserted when the prices were low.

Many people have been familiar with this ruse. For example, a 1970s economic commentator named Barry Ritholtz joked that Greenspan's core inflation metric can more accurately be described as "inflation exinflation," meaning inflation after all of the inflation has been excluded. This demonstrates that the deception of seniors has been intentional, and it continues with a new notion called the chained CPI that will cost seniors even more.

The fact is that government has deceitfully stolen right from the pockets of our beloved seniors by denying them a fair cost of living increase. Some have even suggested that the government believes a natural limit exists on the criticism this could engender because over time, many of the complaints will be silenced by their deaths. Charming.

Walter J. Williams, an American blessing who operates the Shadowstats site has demonstrated that seniors have been stiffed by much more than just 125% and in fact should be receiving more than 4 times what their dollars were worth in 1980. That's \$450 instead of \$100.00. Any senior would love to have even a small proportion of that loss back.

I hope I have convinced you all that seniors have been ripped off and are being ripped off financially by their government. Congress is the real culprit.

So, what do I recommend for now? A gradual remedy. Since it would be difficult to give seniors the proper increase immediately needed to offset this quagmire caused by government malfeasance, my recommendation would be to approach it gradually, in a way that seniors would be somewhat pleased, and be able to live out their golden years in a more dignified manner.

For the next four years, the COLA boost that I'd recommend would be 15% above the real inflation rate. After four consecutive years, that should be sufficient to remove seniors from the on-deck circle they

currently occupy directly outside the homeless shelter. That's all it would take.
