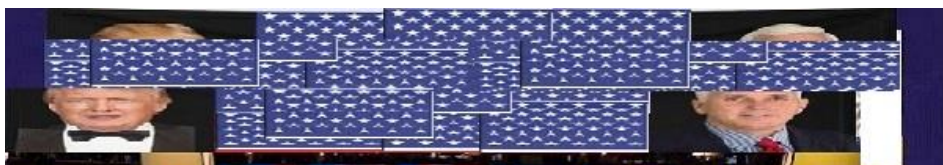

I estimate that this penalty, when enforced by Joe Biden will cost low-income families an average of about \$700 a year. This includes those whose employers aren’t penalized. The penalty’s effect on job availability would make its cost felt by a wide swath of workers. No taxes turned out to be the first broadcast of Fake News. Joe Biden promises more.

Obamacare included many other significant taxes that Obama had Biden hid so well and the corrupt press covered up to make them invisible. Even the Congressional Budget Office overlooked their effects when it originally scored the bill 2010. Later CBO had to backtrack. Backtrack is another way of saying the Democrats were forced to tell the truth because the people demanded it.

Today Mr. Biden takes a similarly veiled approach to advancing the “clean energy revolution and environmental justice” outlined in his platform. The regulatory costs of each quintile are estimated as a percentage of each quintile’s average income. The costs to the bottom group amount to 15.3% of its total income—representing a burden equal to all the taxes they currently pay. This group would experience part of the

cost as lower wages, but the biggest bite would come in diminished purchasing power due to higher prices for energy, cars and other consumer goods. In other words, your purchasing power will go down and the number of dollars you keep will be minimal. Ask Joe Biden about that?

If that weren't enough to convince you that Biden's tax plan would be disastrous for American workers, five independent analyses have concluded that Biden would raise taxes on middle-class Americans:

Lenders made millions of loans to borrowers who, under normal market conditions, weren't able to pay them off. These decisions have cost lenders, especially leading financial institutions, tens of billions of dollars. We saw what happened in the sub-prime loan crisis. It was Community Organizers that forced the banks to provide mortgage loans to those who had no chance to pay them back. Nice idea if to was not so costly to America.

Though from my eyes at the time, but I am white, there was no blatant racism problem in the country for Obama to solve, I felt that the Obama presidency would really be post-racial. 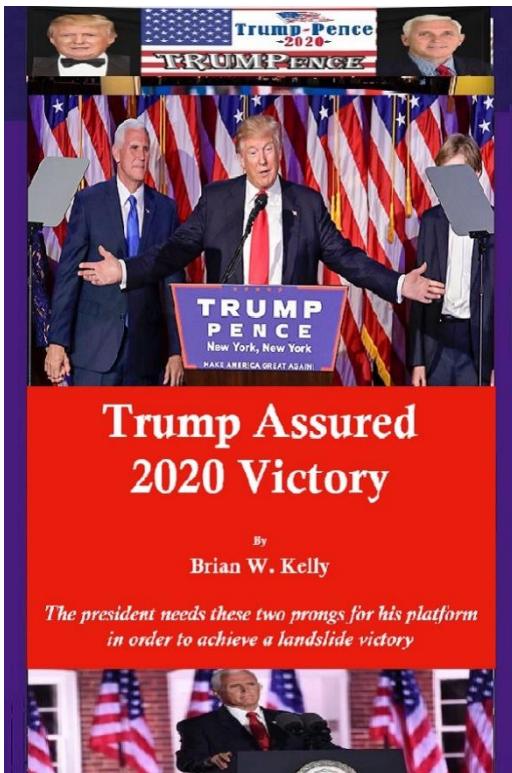

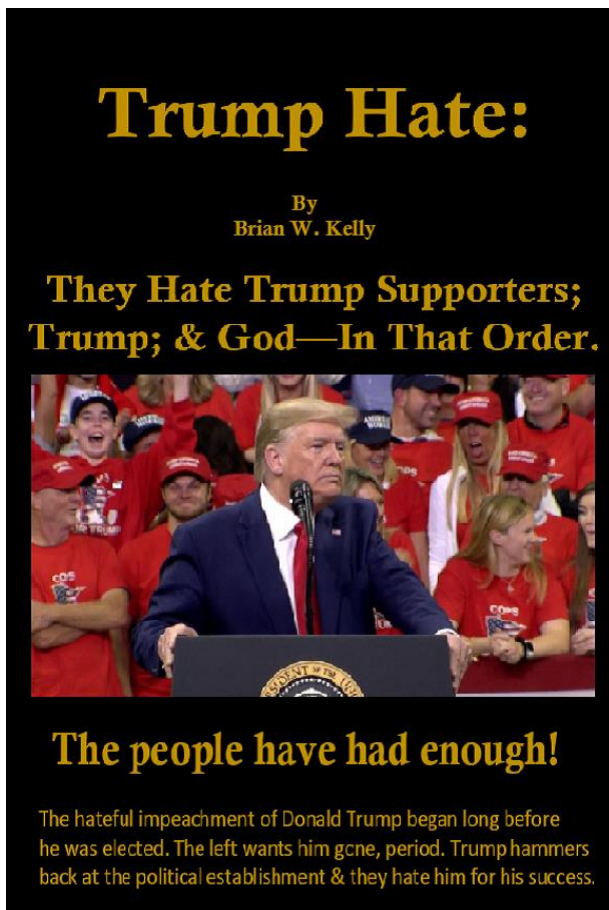

Heck, when he contracted COVID, those who have come to truly love him for his demeanor and his accomplishments, the people—they kept a vigil outside of Walter Reed Hospital hoping their positive attitudes would help cure the President.

The liberal press thinks that the Latino support for Trump is counterintuitive considering he rose to power on what

In his famous 2015 Arizona speech that launched his presidential campaign, Trump referred to a problem with unrestricted crossovers with no concern for who enters our country. He noted the truth that America gets too big a share of good people along with its share of unvetted rapists and drug dealers. It was true then and still is. Those entering illegally have no compunction about committing crime. Everybody knows that their mere entry into the country is against the law. Americans love Trump for stopping it with the wall.

Many of Trump's Latino supporters in Arizona (the Copper State,) point to Trump's business-oriented policies, such as lowering taxes and lifting regulations, as more consequential actions that, they say, have benefited wages and employment levels in their communities. This, along with religious conservatism particularly antiabortion stances are the reasons they want to see him reelected.

They are fine with being part of the national love affair with President Trump. Although a majority of the group had traditionally supported the other party, more Latino voters believe and say they now find more common ground with Republican principles, challenging the notion of a monolithic voting bloc.

A common theme of irritation creates comments such as this from a middle aged Latino: "It infuriates me that the government puts me in a box and calls me a Latino or a Hispanic or minority female...It doesnt work for me, because I am no different than other Americans in terms of

the things that interest me: to be able to put food on my table, to have a job.” Amen sister!

“Most Latinos here, we are all in the same boat, especially the ones coming from Mexico like me. We are luchadores, entrepreneurs, we fight for what we want. We just want to be left alone, and the government to let markets flow.” That is why they like Trump.

Latino's like the fact that Trump has a willingness to fight back against the political establishment, the media and the Democratic leadership. It is that refreshing attitude of Trump's that won many over. They say they will vote for Trump again on Nov. 3, 2020.

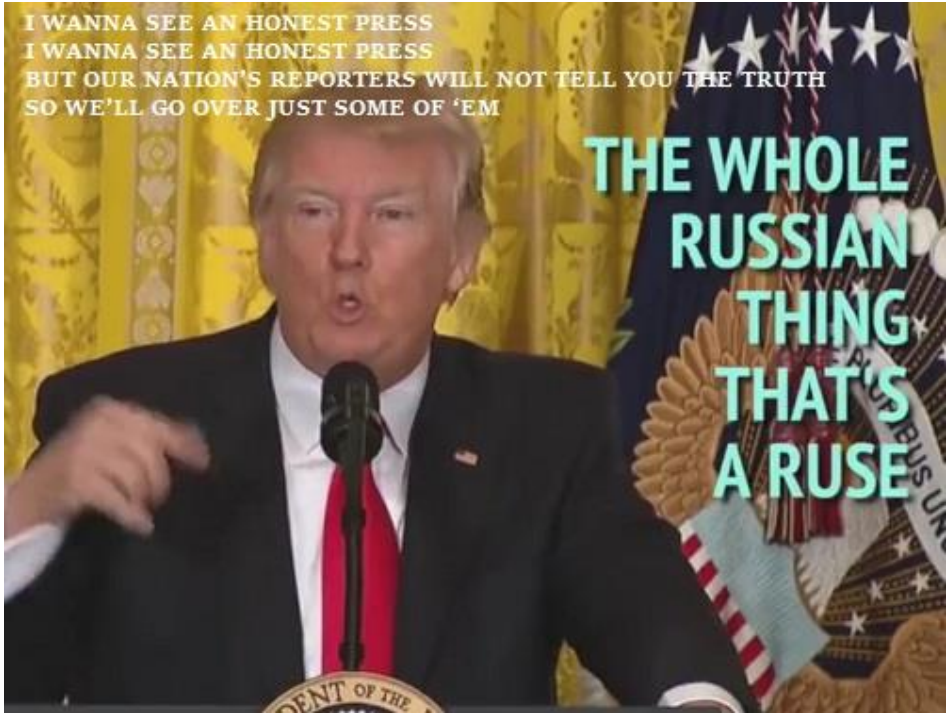

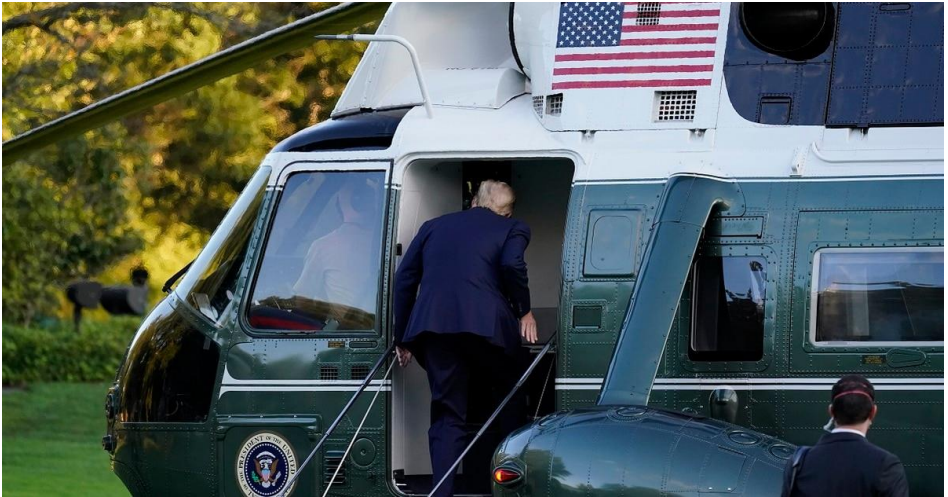

Faced with those possibilities, most Americans probably don't care that Trump relied on eminent domain to grab up a final quarter acre of property for a hotel, or that he boils the blood of the Muslim Brotherhood thugs running the Council on American-Islamic Relations.

While Attorney General Loretta Lynch's greatest fear was that someone might give a Muslim a dirty look, most Americans were more worried about being gunned down at a shopping mall by a crazed lunatic who treats his prayer mat better than his three wives and who thinks 72 virgins are waiting for him in paradise.
